Audio Visual Technician

Purpose of this Position: To maintain all audio/visual and computer equipment.

Essential Functions & Responsibilities: To identify and respond to the sound, visual and computer operation needs of a program event; assure the AV for the event is planned, organized, documented and fully functioning; provide training to groups and individuals, as needed.

Other Duties: Assure properly functioning set-up, organized storage and proper inventory of all audio/visual and computer equipment and supplies; run all AV and computer equipment, as needed; work with the directors, volunteers and hired staff and personnel to create the most efficient sound and visual quality and appropriate and exciting features for each service. Assist in check-in, grounds maintenance, housekeeping, dishwashing, activities and other duties, as assigned.

Supervisory Responsibilities: This position may have volunteers or other staff working with him/her.

Knowledge & Skills: Experience in setting up and running sound equipment; experience in operating computers, media projectors, VCR, DVD and programs such as Media Shout and Microsoft Windows XP; excellent organization and public relation skills.

Fiscal Responsibility: This position may require purchasing or ordering equipment or supplies. All purchases made on behalf of the camp must follow appropriate steps set forth by Impact 2818.

Extent of Public Contact: Extensive contact with campers, volunteers and parents.

Working Conditions and Physical Demands: At any given time may need to run, sit, squat, bend and twist to perform duties; perform simple and power grasping, pushing, pulling and fine manipulation; lift or carry weight of 50 lbs or less; walk for extended periods of time.
