## Horse Camp Director

**Purpose of this Position:** To plan, prepare for and implement age appropriate spiritual aspects & non-horse activities for each week of Horse Camp.

**Essential Functions & Responsibilities:** Set up Horse Camp facilities pre-season; Supervise Horse Camp counselors; Organize Horse Camp volunteer counselors; Ensure the duties of Spiritual Director, Praise & Worship Coordinator, Counselor Coordinator and Activities Coordinator are fulfilled each week; Care and organization of Horse Camp facilities and equipment (excluding barn & riding equipment); Maintain up to date inventory of Horse Camp equipment & supplies (excluding barn & riding equipment); Close down Horse Camp facilities at end of season.

**Other Duties:** Assist in Camper Check-In & Closing Celebration; Grounds Maintenance; Housekeeping; Dishwashing; Perform related duties as assigned.

**Supervisory Responsibilities:** Supervise Horse Camp counselors & volunteers.

**Knowledge & Skills:** Understanding of the developmental stages of students grades 3-13; Experience or knowledge in equine activity programming; Experience supervising others; Excellent organizational and public relation skills.

**Fiscal Responsibility:** This position may require purchasing or ordering supplies. All purchases made on behalf of the camp must follow appropriate steps set forth by Impact 2818.

**Extent of Public Contact:** Extensive contact with campers, volunteers and parents.

**Working Conditions and Physical Demands:** At any given time may need to run, sit, squat, bend or twist to perform duties; Perform simple and power grasping, pushing, pulling and fine manipulation; Lift or carry weight of 50 lbs or less; Walk for extended periods of time.
