Purpose of this Position: To provide preventative and emergency medical treatment and send to area hospitals for major treatments.

Essential Functions & Responsibilities: To be on-site and available all times campers are on-site; secure all camper medications and assure they are taken at the proper times; follow Impact 2818's documented standard medical practices; maintain documentation of all medications, allergies, medical treatments and consultations.

Other Duties: Set Up and maintain medical facilities; secure and provide adequate inventory of medical supplies; collect all medications and vital medical information during Camper Check-In; return medications during Closing Celebrations. Assist in grounds maintenance, housekeeping, dishwashing, activities and other duties, as assigned.

Supervisory Responsibilities: This position may have volunteers or other staff working with him/her.

Knowledge & Skills: Experience in the recognition and proper treatment of medical conditions and situations; understanding of the developmental stages of students; excellent organization and public relation skills.

Fiscal Responsibility: This position may require purchasing or ordering supplies. All purchases made on behalf of the camp must follow appropriate steps set forth by Impact 2818.

Extent of Public Contact: Extensive contact with campers, volunteers and parents.

Working Conditions and Physical Demands: At any given time may need to run, sit, squat, bend and twist to perform duties; perform simple and power grasping, pushing, pulling and fine manipulation; lift or carry weight of 50 lbs or less; walk for extended periods of time; physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring CPR or first aid.
