What is Impact 2818 and That Thing?

Impact 2818 is a Christian Camping Ministry in northern Indiana. For the summer of 2009, we are launching a brand new, cutting-edge program for senior high students called That Thing. It is going to be off the hook amazing, but we need stellar young leaders like yourself to be the brain engineers to make it happen!

So what does this internship entail?

As an intern, you will live, work, worship and play with fellow interns! The experience begins with teambuilding as we prepare to serve together and ends with running four weeks of an amazing senior high program. Gain skills in leadership, event planning, production, video and photography. Make an impact on the lives of over 1,000 Sr. High students while gaining valuable ministry and leadership experience.

The internship includes developing creative programming to run a total of 5 hours of programming in the auditorium each day, for a total of 25 hours of programming each week. Tech savvy individuals will be needed to run lighting, motion graphics, presentation, power point slides, etc. Interns will help design and create elements of the spiritual journey that students will experience within the auditorium. Nine separate journeys (sessions) will be created to get students from point A to point B. Interns will work on the creative side of what that looks like: videos, skits, atmosphere, etc.

There are two Internship tracks. The first is for those who want to spend spring semester on the planning side, then help run the event in the summer. The second track is for those wanting just a summer opportunity.

Internship - Track One

- Full Time Intern (8 available spots)
- January 12 – July 26, 2009
 - Part Time (around 20 hours/week) January 12 – May 16
 - Full Time (around 40 hours/week) May 17 – July 26
- Each intern is required to raise \$2,800. Any amount raised above that will go to the intern in addition to the weekly stipend.
- Impact 2818 provides housing and an \$80/week stipend (from support raised)
- Leadership Opportunities
 - One full time intern will be chosen for the summer Assistant Program Manager position and receive additional pay during the summer weeks
 - One full time intern will be chosen for the Head Counselor position
- Training, Skills and Experience
 - Plan/Prep Activities
 - Assist in Pre-Production for General Sessions
 - Create Videos for General Sessions
 - Collaborate on Creative Writing Projects
 - Promote That Thing through Road Shows
 - Event Management
 - Responsibilities of Summer Intern tasks (see below)

Internship - Track Two

- Summer Intern (8 available spots)
- May 17 – July 26, 2009
- Each intern is required to raise \$1,000. Any amount raised above that will go to the intern in addition to the weekly stipend.
- Impact 2818 provides housing and an \$80/week stipend (from support raised)
- Training, Skills and Experience
 - Be a Fun Engineer
 - Run Activities
 - Assist with Auditorium Production (lighting, video, graphics, etc)
 - Be a Campus House Counselor
